

RESOLUTION NO. 856

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TRIBAL GAMING CASINO WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CASCADE LOCKS, OREGON; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 851.

WHEREAS, a survey of the public was conducted in the City of Cascade Locks and an extensive information packet on Indian Casinos was mailed, with the survey, to all registered voters of the City of Cascade Locks; and

WHEREAS, the results of the survey indicated that 68% of those responding supported a casino and 32% of those responding opposed a casino; and

WHEREAS, the City designated a negotiating team to meet with representatives of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon to negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding, which would become part of a compact between the Confederated Tribes and the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding between the City's negotiating team and the representatives of the Confederated Tribes is in the process of being concluded in a form acceptable to the City Council;

THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CASCADE LOCKS, HOOD RIVER COUNTY, OREGON, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Council Declaration of Support. The City Council hereby declares its support for an Indian Gaming Casino to be located in the City of Cascade Locks in the event the Confederated Tribes obtains all required legal permits to locate the casino at the current site owned by the Port of Cascade Locks (known as Government Rock) and upon which the Confederated Tribes has purchased an option. This consent to support the location of an Indian Gaming Casino in Cascade Locks is based upon the indication from the survey that a majority of the population of the City supports an Indian Gaming Casino, and is conditioned upon the negotiated terms of the Memorandum of Understanding being included in the State compact agreed to by the Confederated Tribes and the State of Oregon.

SECTION 2. Repeal of Prior Resolutions. City of Cascade Locks Resolution No. 851 is hereby repealed.

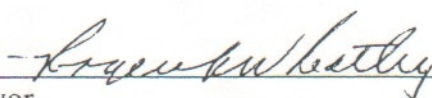
SECTION 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Expiration. This resolution shall remain in effect until December 31, 2005.

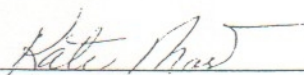
